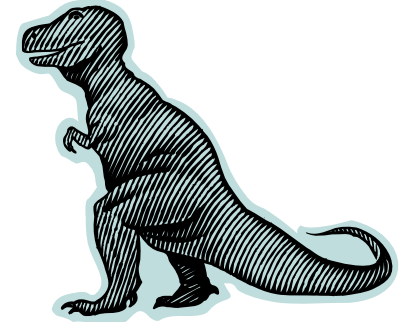

This is where you write the ROUGH DRAFT of your report. Change your point-form notes into sentences.

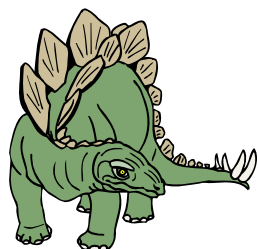
